County Election/Appointments

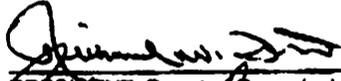

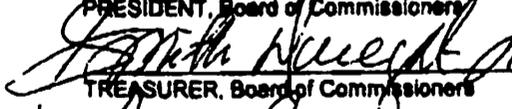

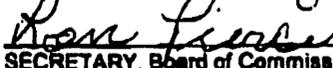
